

"Emotional" Project Management

The application of project management methods supports and structures the communication in projects. Project owners, project managers as well as project team members can manage projects by emotionalization. Methods that emotionalize are e.g. presentations and project vernissages, project score cards, visualizing the project status and common agreements to assure commitment in the project team.

Differences in Project Teams: A Chance and a Challenge

Differences in project teams are the basis for creativity in projects. Possible differences in project teams are e.g. men and women, young and old, professional disciplines, companies, regions or nationalities. These differences have to be managed by establishing a common big project picture and by developing common rules in the project team.

Virtual Organizations have no Emotions?

Representatives of different companies cooperate in virtual projects and perform project tasks. Although the project team members are working at different locations, they are expected to be loyal to the project. "Leave your business card at the project door step" represents this attitude. Transparency and trust, proven by the application of "open books", are project success factors.

Burn-out and High-life in the Project-oriented Company

The attractivity of projects for project managers and project team members often leads to an overload of project work for these individuals. The combination of such an overload of work with frustration because of unclear project objectives and missing context information can lead to burn-out of members of project organizations.

On the other hand, professional starts and close-downs of projects will support high-life feelings in the project-oriented company.

Passion for the Project Management Profession

Lobbying, marketing and public relations in project-oriented companies and in the project-oriented society are necessary to ensure the acceptance of the new profession "project manager". Emotional intelligence is a core competence of project managers and of managers in project-oriented companies. These competences can be evaluated in assessment centers for project and programme managers.


